MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL JANUARY 26, 2022

Dear IHM families,

After much deliberation, the teachers and I have come to the conclusion that we will follow suit with LAUSD and **no longer be offering Zoom as an option for students beginning Tuesday, February 1st.** We understand that the recent surge raised a lot of anxiety and concerns. Unfortunately, the accommodation for Zoom has been misused, causing a detriment in students' mental, social, and academic well-being. This has not been an easy decision to make; however, because our goal is to provide a quality education to our students that focuses on their development of faith, character, and academic excellence, we have deemed this a necessary step towards upholding our mission.

The following are our guidelines for COVID-related absences:

If your child has come into close contact with someone who has tested positive for
COVID-19, please quarantine for 5 days. On day 5, have your child tested. If negative
and no symptoms arise, they may return to school. Proof of the negative test result
must be provided and will qualify your child as "Excused Absence."
If your child tests positive for COVID-19, they must complete a 10 day quarantine.
Submit the initial positive test result in order to calculate the quarantine period. The

Both instances will be treated similarly to excused absences prior to the pandemic. Rather than attending classes via Zoom, students will be given a reasonable amount of time to make up any missed work.

provided positive test result will also qualify your child as "Excused Absence."

We have already seen a huge decline in the amount of positive cases within our community. Rest assured, we are taking all the necessary precautions towards ensuring that our school

will remain a safe place for our students. We thank you for doing your part in testing your children frequently, monitoring for symptoms, and keeping your children home if unwell.
