Halloween is right around the corner! We will be following the CDC's guidelines regarding best practices for preventing the spread of COVID-19 during our **Halloween parade on Friday, October 29th**. Luckily, the majority of our activities will be held outside and mask wearing is part of the holiday. However, it is important that we continue to consider the following:

- ✓ Costume masks are not a substitute for a COVID-19 face masks.
- ✓ All non-student guests are required to be fully vaccinated. Please send proof of vaccination to your child's teacher by Friday, October 22nd.
- ✓ Regardless of vaccination status, visitors should not attend if they have symptoms of COVID-19 or if they are under isolation or quarantine orders.

Doing so will allow us to obtain reading and math intervention, academic counseling, and even parent workshops.
- Now that Dennis has completed their inventory counts, **we will be enforcing dress code for all students beginning on Monday, October 18th**. Please take this weekend to purchase uniforms (non-uniform jackets will no longer be allowed), find all black shoes/socks without logos, and cut your hair. Students will be cited once for uniform violations. After that, parents will be called of those students not following dress code.
- October is the month of the **Holy Rosary**. We will be praying the Rosary every Thursday following morning announcements. Bring your rosaries to school and pray with us!
- We will have an additional **COVID testing event** this Friday, October 15th for anyone interested. If you have already filled out a Cali COVID Control postcard in the past, you will not have to do so again. If you have not yet filled one out but would like to participate, please write the confirmation number on the postcard and bring it with you to school on Friday. We also need **volunteers to help with swabbing students**. If you are interested, please come to the school around 9:15 AM to aid with the testing.
- Opportunities for **service hours** include: lunch yard duty (11:00 AM-1:15 PM), after school during EDP (2:00-6:00 PM), choir study hall (Tuesdays 3:00-4:00 PM) and Mass (Fridays 8:00-9:30 AM). Volunteers are asked to show proof of vaccination and are encouraged to be VIRTUS trained/fingerprinted. Please email me if interested.
