**Arrival:** Turn onto Alexandria from Santa Monica. Please be cautious of the line of cars that may be there in front of you. Wait your turn as children can only safely disembark from the first two vehicles. Staff members will escort your child out and into our front entrance gate.

**Dismissal:** Enter through our gate on Santa Monica and proceed to the lunch benches where your child will be waiting. After a staff member has helped your child into the car, exit through the Alexandria gate. Please do not double park in the lot or on the streets.
