We are very excited to inform you that the ASISA Sports Program will be returning to IHM on Monday, Sept. 11th through December with a potential to continue through the Spring. This after-school program is available for students in grades 1-8. Logistics are as follows:

- Students in grades 1-3 will be offered soccer on Mondays from 3-5 PM. Students in grades 4-8 are offered basketball on Tuesdays from 3-5 PM. Students must be signed out by 5 pm or they will be signed into EDP.
- If you are interested, please complete the "Parent Consent for Title IV Enrichment Services" form and submit it to the office as soon as possible. There is only space available for 30 students for each program and spots will surely fill up fast! Availability will be on a first come, first served basis. A wait list will be created after the limit has been reached.
- Missing 2 consecutive weeks of the program without a valid excuse will result in termination from the program in order to make room for students on the waitlist.
