This is a friendly reminder that if you have not yet completed your back-to-school forms on Schoolspeak, please make sure to do so as soon as possible. These are past due as they were to be submitted by August 31st. Thank you for your quick attention to this matter.

Also, a reminder that family income surveys were sent home with your eldest child this past Monday and were due yesterday. If you have not yet turned them back in, please do so by tomorrow. The data from these surveys make us eligible for Title services, such as after-school programs (i.e. ASISA), reading and math intervention, and counseling. The information determines the amount of funds the school district will set aside for these special services. All you need to do is circle YES or NO after each question. Your answers will be strictly confidential. Names are optional and will not be given to anyone. We implore your assistance in helping us to keep these services.
